SOURDOUGH SAM COMPETITION:

- Each Patrol will present a Breakfast Sample, Judging will include:
 - Main Dish and Sides
 - Entry must be sent to the Judges Table no later than 8:30 am
 - Each entry must include the Entry Submission Form, filled out completely.
- Each Patrol will present a Dinner Sample, Judging will include:
 - Main Dish, Sides & Desert Entry must be sent to the Judges Table no later than 5:30 pm
 - Each entry must include the Entry Submission Form, filled out completely.
- Judging Criteria:
 - Presentation: Creative Name, Plating, and quick story of why they decided to cook their submission.
 - Taste, Flavor, Does the food look edible, pleasing to see, makes you want to eat it.



Trout Lake Pavilion Setup:

- 7 Patrol Cooking areas spread evenly around Hey Pavilion with Kitchens facing out. Venture Patrol Area see Connie
- Patrol equipment box should be on ground under Kitchen.
- In front of kitchen should be two Picnic Tables in a “L” shape, one for Demo area (Patrol Eating Table for meals), one for Stove & Wash Station

Cooks: Each will plan a Main Dish and a Second Item (Appetizer, Side Dish or Desert) They should submit an Entry Submission Form for everything they are cooking.

1. You should plan to make enough food for bites for 85 people, roughly 2-3 Full Size portions per patrol.
2. Cooks & assistants are responsible for cleaning and putting away all Patrol Equipment used.
