

## Ideas That Will Help Your Unit Have a Great Weekend

Bring only what you need for high-density camping. With over 3500 Scouts and Scouters expected to camp for the weekend, it is strongly suggested that you bring only what you need.

Try to carpool and combine your gear, equipment, and Scouts into as few vehicles as possible PACK LIGHT.

Bring a wagon or a hand cart to help haul equipment from vehicles to your campsite.

Handicapped parking will be available. The vehicle must display the appropriate placard or license plate in order to obtain access to this special parking area.

In the past, some units have expressed concerns about the size of their respective camp site. Rest assured that everyone will receive an equal distribution of the available camping area. Please review item bullet point 2.

PACK LIGHT

Parking lots will open at 5:00 PM on Friday, May 17.

When your unit arrives, assign one person to check in to the Campmaster. Packets with information, wristbands and Jambo patches will be given out after your group has set-up your camp site.

Remember that we are guests of Kutztown University. We are extremely fortunate to have a host that is as generous as they are, and we want to continue to have more events there in the future. Leave the grounds in better condition than you found them.

When you pack up on Sunday morning, please inspect your campsite to be certain that you removed all stakes and debris from your site.

No open fires will be permitted. This also means charcoal fires in barrels, half-barrels, grills, hibachis, or any other container. No charcoal!!! Only camp stoves will be permitted in the camping areas.

We appreciate all of your efforts to make this an enjoyable event. If you see something you like, let somebody know. If you see something you don't like, try to correct it, and if you cannot, let somebody know.

If you enjoyed yourself, think about volunteering to help similar events happen in the future. Ask at your next District Roundtable about helping these events occur.

Again PACK LIGHT and CAR POOL.....enjoy a great weekend!

The BSA GUIDE TO SAFE SCOUTING will apply for all activities. National policy for uniforms and conduct will also apply.

Smoking is prohibited by Minsi Trails Council and Kutztown University. This is a non-smoking event.

Alcohol is prohibited by Minsi Trails Council, Kutztown University, and the Boy Scouts of America.

No ATV's (all-terrain vehicles) are permitted on Kutztown property.

Remember take only pictures and leave only footprints. Leave no Trace practices for high density camping apply. In 2008, 2010, 2012, 2015 we were complemented for a low impact visit to KU. Let's earn those compliments again in 2019!

Use only walkways, cross streets at crosswalk only. Act like scouts at all times, we will be visible to the public.

There are neighbors on lands near our camping areas and Kutztown University. For this reason, quiet hours are observed in the camping area between the hours of 11:00 pm and 6:00 am. Leaders are responsible to see that all scouts are in their own Unit's site during these hours.

Water is availability in designated camping area.

Gas/Diesel Generators are NOT ALLOWED in any camping area. Simply, don't bring them. If you do, our committee will ask you to remove it from the property.

Comfort stations are to be kept clean at all times. Your cooperation is essential to maintain these facilities in a clean and sanitary manner. Each will be marked male or female. Handicap comfort stations are also available at each station site.

Digging is NOT ALLOWED for any reason. This includes tent trenching, field toilets, etc.

No fires on the ground. No charcoal fires. No fires in barrels or half-barrels. All cooking is to be done with camping stoves only.

All tents & fly's must be staked down, so they do not become windblown hazards.

Please confirm that special needs, e.g. handicap parking, or handicap camping are understood with the JAMBO Camp Masters.

We are guest of the Kutztown University and are expected to act like guest at all times. Always abide by the scout oath and law. Let's have fun and a great time!
